How Can You Report Crime?

Not all crimes can be acted on immediately however the information that we hold as communities can be very valuable. Things that we see, and report can build a picture for future actions, for example the events that occur on the Dilton Marsh Playing Field or Nottingham Knockers. People knocking your door trying to sell to you, Anti-social behaviour, the times it happens and what events occur reported by us using this online address <https://crowd.in/o4jVKA> or (if causing greater concern but not an emergency) via 101, information can be collected for a more efficient outcome. A police officer will not knock on your door, they will phone you if you prefer so that you can remain safer from retaliation, you do not have to put up with anti-social behaviour.

It is not wasting police time to report events online or via 101. The information from these notifications is collated and used to build a picture or evidence of what is causing us concern as a community. For an emergency always use 999.
