P. 26 site allocation A Heli-beds

I agree with this area for development because it is on the main Frome Road and has been previously developed with commercial premises. It does not encroach on any rural areas and can be easily accessed.

p.28 site allocation B Land off Wesley Lane

I agree with development on this site because it will provide the required number of houses so that some will have to be affordable houses. It is easy to access and keeps the development of Southwick along the Frome Road rather than spreading south on other farmland. It will, however, need to be developed with awareness of the possibility of flooding which will have to be mitigated in the development. Bats are frequently seen in Blind Lane, some have lived in our loft (recorded by the bat conservation society) so I think the development will have to take the bats into account. Traffic into and out of Wesley Lane will need controlling which could be good for those in Blind Lane.

I do not support the other areas suggested.
